Overview



\$70M total, \$50M for Round 3,
grants up to \$20,000



Application Open **Dec 2**, apply by
Dec 11 for priority consideration



Business resiliency partners for
application support in language



Priority for businesses under \$5M
revenue and hardest hit sectors



Round 3: Working Washington Small Business Grants

Applications for up to \$20,000 in emergency funding opens early this week

Gov. Jay Inslee announced an additional \$70 million for business grants. \$50 million of this is for Round 3 of the Working Washington Small Business grants. The remainder will go towards funding qualified businesses that applied in earlier rounds of our resiliency grant program.

NOTE: Businesses that applied for the resiliency grant program will not need to take any action

Application site traffic may be high so page load times may be impacted. Applicants are encouraged to be patient or try accessing the site during non-peak hours such as early morning, late evening or the weekend.

Who can apply for Round 3?

These grants are prioritized for:

- Small businesses with annual revenues of \$5 million or less in 2019

AND

Businesses in the sectors that are most impacted by the recent public health measures or sectors that have experienced significant cumulative impacts. Examples include full service restaurants, fitness

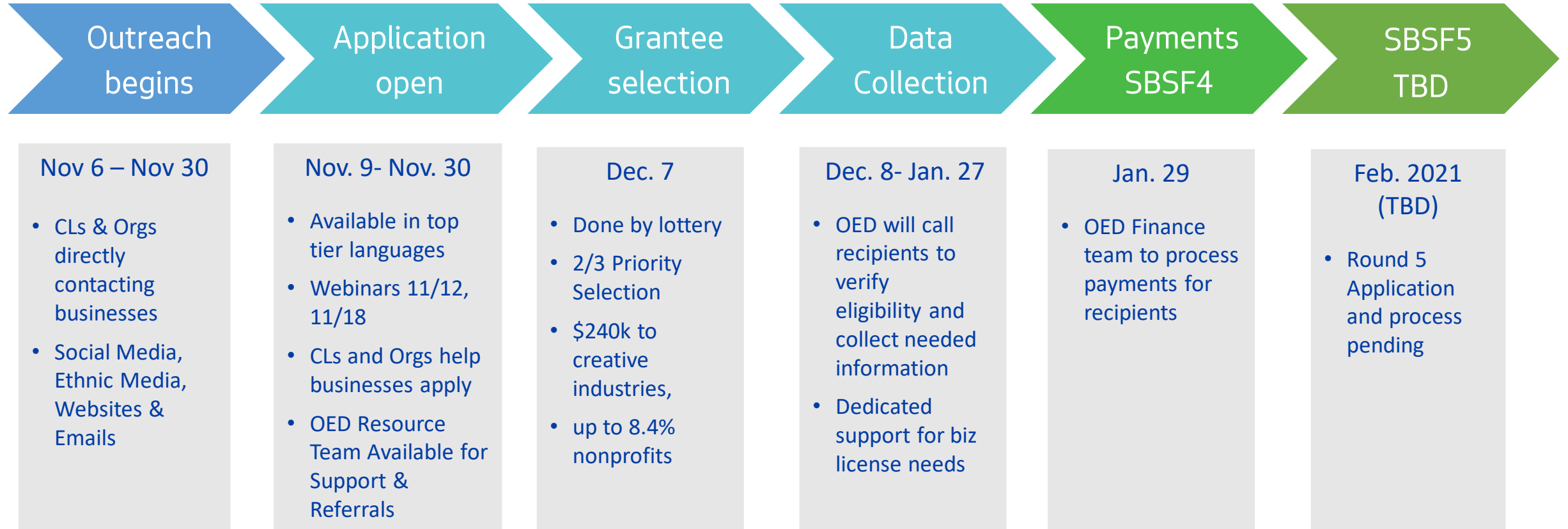

Updated Business Guidance (Nov 16-Dec 14)

Restaurants and Bars

- Closed for indoor service
- Outdoor dining and to-go service continues
- Table size limited to 5 for outdoor dining

Retail, Personal services, Grocery stores

- Limited to 25% capacity



Updated Business Guidance (Nov 16- Dec14)

Fitness Facilities and Gyms

- Closed for indoor operations
- Outdoor activities permitted limited to outdoor gathering restriction (5 people)

Movie Theaters are closed for indoor service

Museums/ Zoos/ Aquariums closed for indoor service
